Tuesday 20th Sept **“Golf”** at the Kiama Golf Club, 79 Oxley Ave, Kiama Downs

Be there 8.30am. Hit off time 8.45 to 9am.

12 Players and 3 carts booked for 18 holes event.

Green Fees \$30 p.p. and shared cart \$20 per person. The course is reasonably flat except for one steep climb so you can take your own buggy if you choose.

Should finish playing about 1pm. Lunch and beer at the club at own expense.

“Farewell Lunch” From 12 noon at the historical Jamberoo Pub, 12 Allowrie St,
Jamberoo. Approx. 10 km west of Kiama

The hotel has a lot of memorabilia and the town has historical buildings and boutique shops.

After lunch you have the option to take an 8 minute drive to the Minnamurra Rainforest Centre and do a 1.6 km easy sloping walk to see Lyrebirds, water dragons and ancient figs trees as well as waterfalls.

On the way back to our Park you could take alternative route to “Saddleback Mountain Lookout” where you can view from Cronulla in the north to Milton in the south. Further down the road visit the “Dry Stone Walls” over 400 stone walls constructed over 100 years ago.

“Happy Hour” with optional BBQ evening meal at the park **BBQ area** from say 4.30pm.
