

## Mudgee Caravan & Cabin Getaway October Report

We are now down to 68 members for the Mudgee getaway. 20 keen golfers, 45 for the Gooree Park winery and approx. 66 for lunch at the Gulgong Bowling Club. A pretty good effort considering the problems with COVID-19 and all the changes we have had to make to fit in with members concerns. Give yourself a clap.

We have some good news for those people that are doing the wine trip to Gooree Park.

- Gooree Park has generously offered a discount off their normal price for those that are only doing the Self-Drive, Wine Tasting and Lunch, however there will be no morning tea. You will now only pay \$35 instead of \$55. A saving of \$20 which will be refunded in cash at Mudgee.
- The 20 people that are doing the Horse Stud tour, we have a great offer for you. Instead of driving and using Gooree Park's small 10 seater bus to do two separate tours We now have our own bus which will pick up and return us from the caravan park for an extra \$5 per head on top of the \$65 that you have already paid. The \$5 will be collected in cash prior to boarding the bus. This same bus will transport us through the property on our Horse Stud Tour. The 20 seater bus will only be available for those doing the Horse Stud tour and will pick up from the caravan park at 10 am and return about 2 pm.
- Gooree Park has agreed to run their 10 seater bus after lunch for a 2<sup>nd</sup> Horse Stud tour. 10 of our self-drive members have chosen this tour costing \$60. They had already paid \$55 so was only extra \$5 per head.

Because of the split group situation Gooree Park will **not** be serving morning tea as it doesn't make sense for the whole group to arrive at 10.30 am. For those only doing the self-drive wine/ lunch tour you will not be required to arrive at Gooree Park until 11.45 am. You may wish to spend some time at the Honey Haven prior to going to Gooree Park. We will all have lunch and wine tasting together from about 12 pm.

Please note that we will be starting the Golf one hour earlier so that our finishing time is not too late for lunch and also the lunch at the Gulgong Bowling Club is now from 12 instead of 12.30 pm this will give you more time to do things in the afternoon. I understand that some of the tourist sights close about 3 pm.

Regular bowlers wishing to have a game at Gulgong will need to have their own equipment. Teams and start time can be arranged say Wednesday evening. Rawson may like to help with this. Please check the latest Itinerary on the website.

We will be having the usual "Happy Hour" every afternoon in the caravan park camp kitchen area from 5 pm. Anyone who wishes to make use of the BBQ area are quite welcome.

Mudgee has lots of fine restaurants, café and cheap pub meals to choose from. Remember that you will only be allowed up to 10 people to sit at a table together.
